For The Cabin

- Blankets + Pillow
- Sleeping Bag and Sheets
- Shower Towels (Please Bring Separate towels for showering and one for the Lake)
- Shower shoes
- Hygiene items (Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap bar, deodorant, etc)
- Socks & Underwear (Please pack enough for the week)
- T-Shirts (Please bring enough for the week as Laundry is not available)
- Your St. Peter Camp T-Shirts from last year
- Pajamas
- Special Outfit for Festive Dinner

For Church (We will have services 2x each day, please consider that when packing clothes for your children)

- Dresses & Skirts (Knee length or below) – Girls
- Long Sleeve shirts – Girls
- Scarves – Girls
- Long Pants – Boys
- Long Sleeve Shirts – Boys
- Prayer Book - Everyone

For The Outdoors

- Bug Spray (Highly Encouraged)
- Sunscreen (Highly Encouraged)
- Beach Towels
- Sneakers (Consider bringing 2 pairs in case one of them gets wet)
- Sandals
- Conservative One-Piece Swimsuit – Girls
- Swim Trunks – Boys
- Hats
- Flashlight

For The Outdoors (Ctd)

- Raincoat & Umbrella
- Reusable Water Bottles
- Clothes for Hot sunny days (T-shirts, shorts)
- Clothes for the evening (Sweatshirts, Sweatpants, It can get Chilly in the Evening)

Please Keep in Mind

- Tights/Legging may **only** be worn with long-length tops.
- Shorts/skirts for everyday use must be finger length from knee or longer
- No V-Neck, low cut shirts/dresses
- No crop tops
- No clothing which displays political slogans or messages
- No Tank-Tops or Muscle Shirts
- Laundry Service is **Not Available** to Campers or Adults
- Please bring all your medications with you to camp. These will be given to the camp nurse along with prescription details
- Cellphones will be collected from Campers when they arrive to camp
- Any valuables, including cash, may be collected by Camp directors if you find it necessary to bring and will be returned to campers at the end of the week. Camp will not be responsible for any lost valuables or cash unless given to Camp Directors upon arrival. A small safe will be utilized by the Camp Directors to store anything provided.
